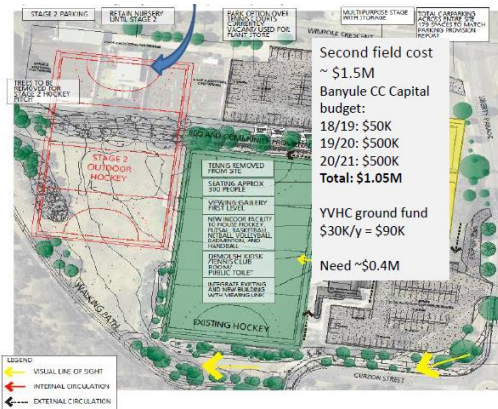

Second pitch planning

Banyule Council are spending \$30K on the feasibility study for our second pitch to the north and west of the current field. This process has been held up by a Melbourne Water sewer pipe in the vicinity and requirements / permits needed to construct on that easement. Hoping to resolve shortly. BCC have committed funding ~ \$1M. Assuming planning permit can be obtained, we will need to find further funds ~\$0.5M for the project to go ahead. We will look to State Government grants and support to bridge this gap.
